If your child is in school please remember they will need a packed lunch, that they can manage independently, each day.

Parents in receipt of benefit related free school meals - You should have received a letter from us at the beginning of the week to advise that the government will be issuing a weekly £15.00 E-Voucher for you to spend at a supermarket for your child's free school meal provision. The voucher, one per every eligible child, will be issued as a replacement for the isolation pack you have received over the last few weeks.
