



This week's Presentation Champion is: Ethan!




Ethan has been trying so hard to improve his presentation. Well done, Ethan! Keep up the great work.

Fantastic Work - Year 4


To finish our science topic on electricity the children created an information text demonstrating their knowledge and understanding of the unit. This is Samuel's work.
