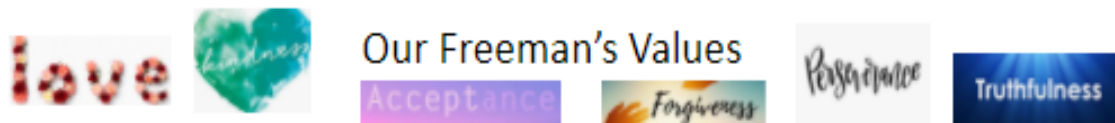

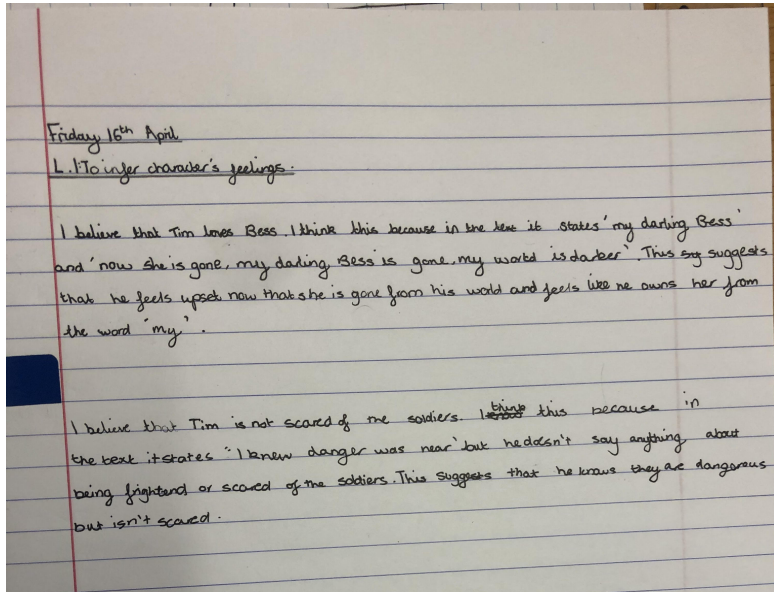

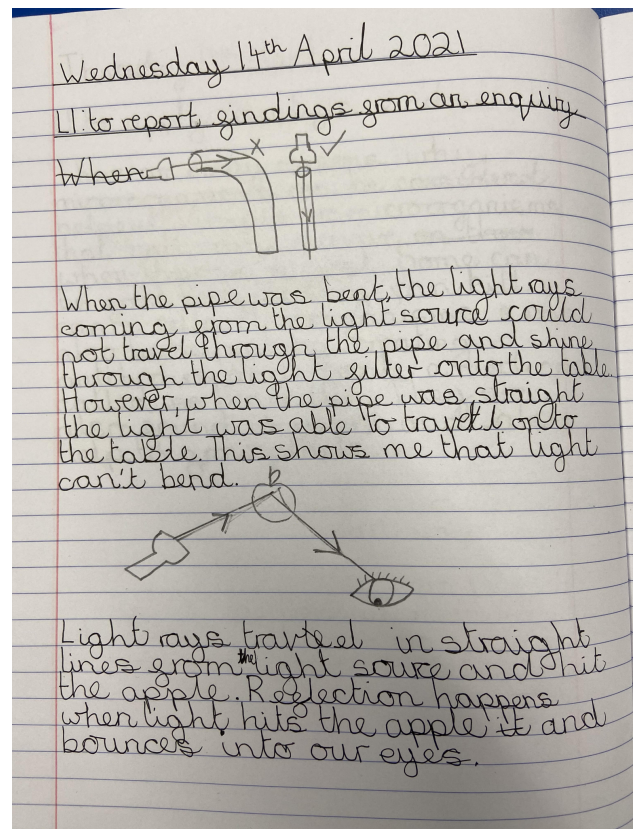
Our House of the Week with the highest number of Dojo points is the **Saints House!**
