Pupil Premium Funding Is your child eligible for Pupil Premium funding?

If so, please apply! Pupil Premium Funding is an annual payment which is used to enhance provision for some of our pupils. People's circumstances regularly change and you may be entitled to this. Your child's school may be entitled to pupil premium funding if you receive one of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit, with no element of Working Tax Credit, and a household income below £16,190 (as assessed by HM Revenue and Customs)
- Guarantee Element of State Pension Credit
- Universal Credit - income dependant


Christmas preparations!
